The Boston Society of Vulcans, in conjunction with the families of Lloyd Phillips, Raymond Moss and Robert Powell, are offering scholarships for \$500.00 each to high school seniors who are Boston residents, or the sons & daughters of Vulcan members. Students who have demonstrated their civic commitment through their involvement in community activities and who plan to attend college during the 2010-2011 school year are encouraged to apply.

Lloyd Phillips, Raymond Moss and Robert Powell were Black Boston Firefighters and community and civic leaders. Lloyd served as a Boston firefighter and recruiter for many years. Raymond Moss served as a vocal activist for the equal treatment of all firefighters. Robert Powell was a founding member of the Vulcan Society, and served as its first chief historian and mentor for over thirty-five years. All members were deeply committed and interested in young adults who demonstrated an interest not only in firefighting, but in their community through their participation in civic activities. They always encouraged young people to pursue careers in public safety along with a college education and lived by the motto of “All That I Am I Owe to Others that Came Before Me.”

Prospective candidates will be asked to write a two page word essay to “**Explain what you have done to make your community a better place to live.**” Award recipients will be selected based on essay content, school transcripts and civic and community activities.
